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POLICIES

ADMISSION

Admission is on a first come first serve basis. According to Federal law, we are prohibited from discriminating on the basis of race, color, national origin, sex, age or disability. Portland Church of the Nazarene (PCN) Child Development Center (CDC) is licensed by the State of Michigan Independence Agency.

PAY SCHEDULE

The registration fee of \$50.00 and the tuition will be due on the first day that the child enrolls. Tuition shall always be paid one week in advance. Checks returned for insufficient funds will be assessed a \$25.00 fee payable before the child(ren) may return to the Portland Church of the Nazarene (PCN) Child Development Center (CDC).

HOURS OF OPERATION

GENERAL INFORMATION

HOLIDAYS

The PCN CDC will be closed on the following holidays if they fall on a weekday: New Years, Memorial Day, 4th of July, Labor Day, Thanksgiving, Christmas Eve, Christmas.

CURRICULUM

PCN CDC emphasizes a developmentally appropriate program focusing on the individual development of each child. Developmental domains include physical development, cognitive development, emotional development, and social development, serving as a focus point for lesson planning.

PCN CDC utilizes *Zoo Phonics* and *Handwriting without Tears* in the Preschool Classrooms. As teachers plan weekly and daily activities they consider each child's developmental level.

The daily **schedule in each classroom will include the following times of day**, with variation depending on the developmental needs of the children.

- Arrival
- Breakfast/AM Snack/Lunch/PM Snack
- Toileting
- Outdoor Play
- Large Group
- Small Group
- Choice Time
- Rest
- Departure

Each classroom also learns Bible verses based on different themes each month (ie. God's love, loving each other, creation, and more). Pre-school children attend chapel 3x/week. All learning is child directed. The children are not forced to learn; rather the material is presented in a fun and exciting way and is a normal part of their learning at the CDC.

SPECIAL EVENTS

The PCN CDC presents a Christmas program and Easter program annually for parents and friends. Plan to enjoy a fun-filled event!
